

Wood Badge Personal Equipment List

- **Wear the official BSA uniform for your current Scouting position.** (Note: A complete uniform includes the official BSA shirt with colored epaulets [shoulder loops] signifying your branch of Scouting; official BSA shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; official BSA socks; and official BSA belt (web or leather). Neckerchief and slide will be provided.
- **There will be occasions to wear a Scout activity uniform** which consists of a Scout T-shirt or Scout knit shirt; official BSA Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes; official BSA socks; and official BSA belt (web or leather).
